Basic requirements:

- 100 hours of Christian Service, with a minimum of 70 hours completed from the following areas:
 - Service to the school community of MCA*
 - Service to the faith community*
 - Service to the civic community*
- 30 hours must be completed in direct service to the needy.
- Transfer students' hours are pro-rated.

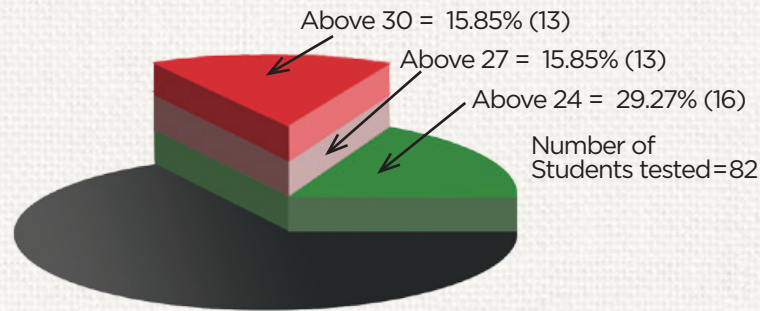
